SCHOLARSHIP

Smithies boast an average 3.6 GPA, an achievement fostered by diversity of majors, diversity of academic years, and an in-house culture that promotes academic excellence.

LEADERSHIP

The Smithies' executive core of four paid positions and seven elected positions is supported by ten standing committees who plan house events including fundraising, community service, and social events.



FELLOWSHIP

Smithies bond by sharing life experiences, competing in university intramurals, teaching house members new games and hobbies, and by simply spending time together.

GOVERNANCE

Student officers manage the day-to-day operations of the house. Each student has equal voice in the weekly house meetings and equal vote during house elections.

A live-in executive director, a non-resident registered dietician, and the alumni operations board coordinate large-scale projects and long-term planning.



LOCATION


A mere three blocks south of the student union and four blocks west of Aggieville, Smith House is a quick walk from classes, gameday festivities, and K-State tradition.


